

- 968 Youth through our Summer Camp, one-day Orientation Sails and yearround classes
- 1,000+ participants through our Community Sailing Events open to the public
- 67 participants through our Family Sails, Adult Classes and Water sports opportunities
- 65 Adaptive Sailors through Blind Sailing and Youth Co-able Classes

Youth Outreach



- Partnerships: TISC partnered with over 34 Bay Area Youth Organizations to provide and educational and active outdoor activities
- Integrative Curriculums: Our curricula instill important life skills of self confidence, goal setting, decision making, teamwork, communications and leadership
- Accessibility: 84% of all youth served attend on full scholarship and originate from predominantly underserved communities
- Diverse Offerings: We offer one day sailing and kayaking trips, weeklong summer camps and year round advanced lessons and racing team programs
 - Internships: Available for at-risk youth

Our outreach efforts and network of 34 community partners allow us to reach new and diverse youth, each year especially those from under-resourced communities




